"20201003 | The Glorious Appearing | Pastor John Lomacang (tvsdac)" was posted on YouTube by the Thompsonville Seventh-day Adventist Church on 10/3/20. From what I've seen, John almost exclusively uses the New King James Version.

Around 1:12:325 you quote Revelation 19:7 from the New King James Version (NKJV) and then ask the question, "What does it mean His wife has made herself ready?" If you had just read the next verse you would have had your answer.

"Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready.' And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints." Revelation 19:7-8 from the NKJV.

Your "the Bible" clearly says the redeemed are clothed with their "righteous acts." The Protestant Bible has a little different wording.

"Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready. And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints." Revelation 19:7-8 from the King James Version (KJV).

And there is this from the Spirit of Prophecy.

"To the church it is given 'that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white,' 'not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing.' The fine linen, says the Scripture, 'is the righteousness of saints.' It is the righteousness of Christ, His own unblemished character, that through faith is imparted to all who receive Him as their personal Saviour." *Christ's Object Lessons* page 310.

So, what do we go with John? Your "the Bible" or the KJV?
